COOKIE MONSTER BIKKIES

what you need:

an adult's help, 2 cups white chocolate melts, 1 tbsp coconut oil, blue food colouring, Oreo biscuits, blue sanding sugar, lolly eyes, choc chip cookies

directions:

- 1 In a medium bowl, combine white chocolate melts, coconut oil and 5 or 6 drops of blue food colouring.
- 2 Microwave at 20 to 30 second intervals until the chocolate has melted. Stir until smooth. (Don't add extra liquid food colouring now the chocolate has melted otherwise the chocolate will 'seize' and be unusable.)
- 3 Line a tray with baking paper.
- 4 Toss each Oreo in the blue chocolate mixture until fully coated. You might like to use a fork to lift it out. Let it drain off slightly and transfer to the baking sheet.
- 5 Sprinkle immediately with sanding sugar then stick two candy eyes on top and a piece of choc chip cookie to the front.
- 6 Let the chocolate set completely before serving (about 10 minutes).



HEY CRAFTY CREW!

FRIENDSHIP BRACELETS



What you need:

a safety pin or sticky tape, scissors, embroidery cottons in different colours, a pillow or cushion

1 For each colour you want to use, cut 2 lengths of cotton 80cm to 1m long. I used 4 colours so had 8 individual strands. You could choose 3 colours, using 6 strands. (Any less than 6 strands makes the finished bracelet a bit too thin.)

2 Take the strands of cotton and tie them together with a knot about 2cm from one end.

3 Safety pin this to a cushion or pillow, or you can tape the end to a tabletop.

4 Roughly divide the strands into 3 and plait together for 3 to 4 cm. Tie off with another knot.

5 Decide what order you want the strands of cotton to be in. This will determine the order of the colour of your rows. I grouped each colour together to make thicker stripes of each colour.

6 Once they're in order, take the first two strands from the left. The strand on the left will create the first knot. You'll be knotting it around the other strands of cotton.

7 Take the first strand and pass it over the second strand and then behind.

8 Hold the second strand taut and pull

the first strand up and towards the large knot at the top. Pull firmly to secure your knot but not hard enough to break the cotton!

9 Repeat to make a second knot on the second strand.

10 Move to the third strand of cotton, creating two knots.

11 Continue moving across to the right, using the first strand to create two knots on each strand of cotton.

12 Once you've knotted all the way across to the right, that first strand is now the last in the row.

13 Begin the process again using the first strand on the left. Make sure you tie two knots on each strand.

14 Keep going until you've reached the length you want.

15 To finish off, tie a knot with all the strands of cotton right at the end of the main part of the bracelet. From that knot, plait another 3 to 4cm, then knot again. Cut off the extra cotton and you're done!

BIBLE MESSAGE

Nothing beats having great mates, except perhaps being a great friend yourself. Good friends care for each other, encourage each other, are kind (not mean or nasty!) and – best of all – have loads of fun together. Who will you make one of my friendship bracelets for? "A friend loves at all times" (Proverbs chapter 17, verse 17).

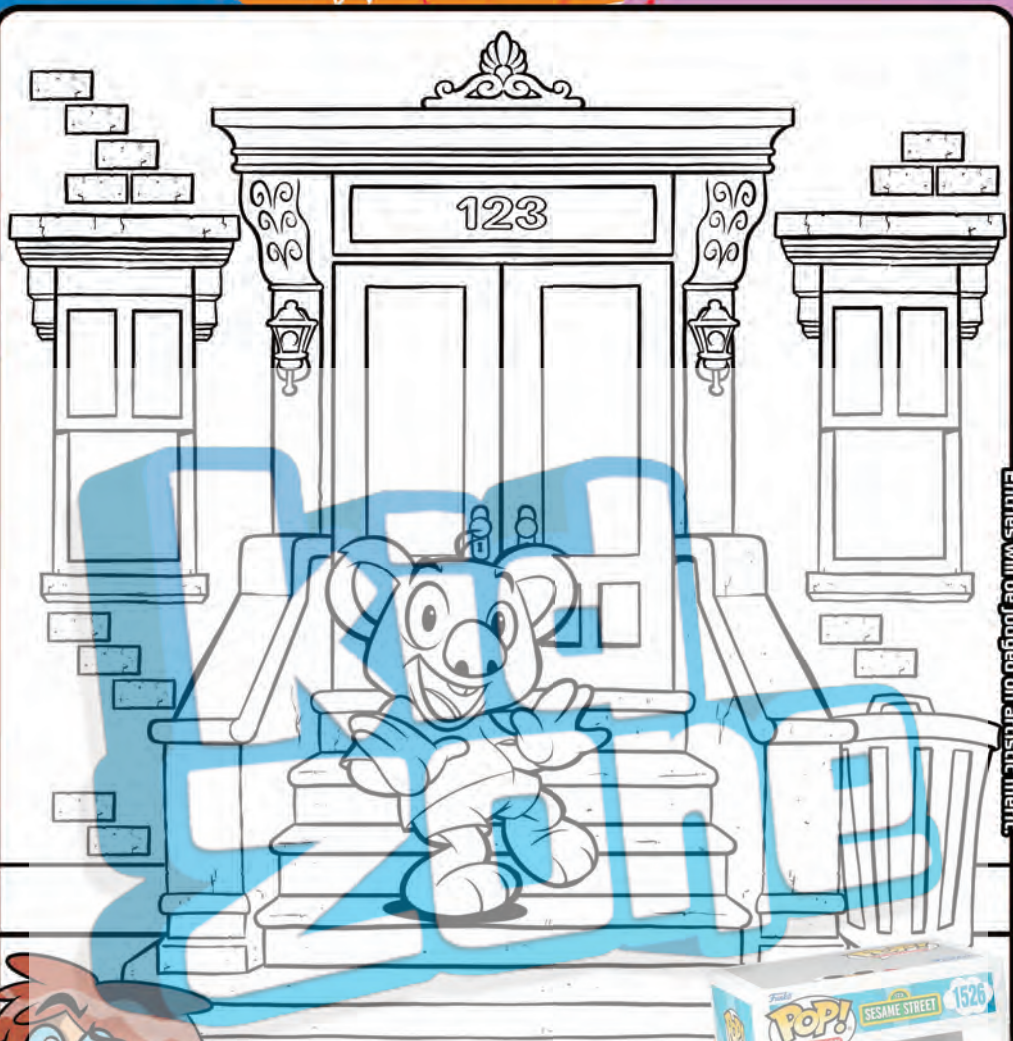

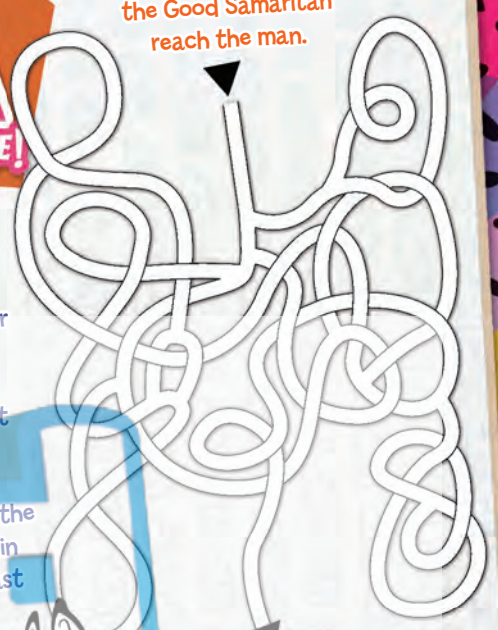
