Remember what the angel told the most joyful news ever announced, and it is for everyone! The Saviour - yes, the Messiah, the Lord - has been born tonight in Bethlehem! How will you recognise him? You will find a baby wrapped in a blanket, lying in a manger!" (Luke chapter two, verses 10-12°).
