5 MAY 1894

The term 'fair dinkum' appeared in print for the first time. 'Fair dinkum' means honest, genuine or real, and it first appeared in The Bulletin magazine. It is thought that the word dinkum came from England, where it meant 'hard work'.

5 MAY 1906

The first electric tram in Melbourne began operating. Today Melbourne boasts the largest operational urban tram network in the world, consisting of 250 km of double track, a fleet of around 500 trams, and more than 1700 tram stops.

6 MAY 1889

The Eiffel Tower was officially dedicated. 324 metres tall, the tower was built as the entrance arch for the 1889 World's Fair and was the world's tallest building for 41 years. It is the most visited monument in the world.

7 MAY 1840

Composer Tchaikovsky was born. He is best known for writing the ballets The Nutcracker, Swan Lake and Sleeping Beauty, and also wrote the 1812 Overture, which uses a real cannon to bring the music to a final climax

LOLLY TEACUPS

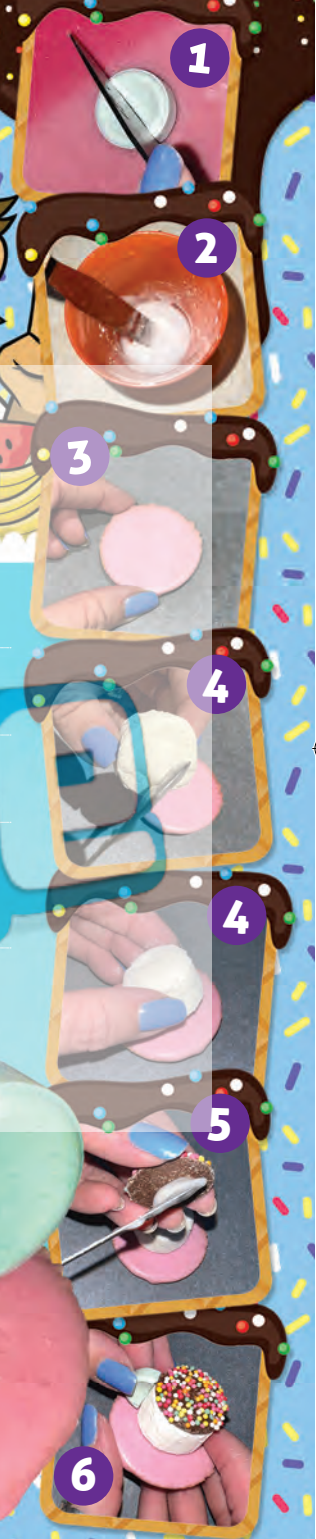
what you need:

an adult's help, icing sugar,
1 iced biscuit, 1 marsh-
mallow, 1 Fruit Tingle
lolly, 1 chocolate
freckle

directions:

- 1 Ask an adult to help you carefully cut a Fruit Tingle lolly in half. Put aside for later.
- 2 Mix together $\frac{1}{4}$ cup of icing sugar with a small amount of water to make a spreadable paste.
- 3 Place an iced biscuit, with the icing side facing up, on a plate. The biscuit is the saucer for the 'teacup'.
- 4 Using a knife or spatula spread a small amount of icing on the base of the marshmallow and stick it in the centre of the biscuit for the teacup.
- 5 Ice the base of a chocolate Freckle and 'paste' it on top of the marshmallow for the 'tea'.
- 6 Use icing to stick one half of a Fruit Tingle lolly onto the side of the marshmallow to form the cup handle.

HEY CRAFTY CREW!

MAKE YOUR OWN FLIP PICTURE



What you need:

A4 sheet of paper,
scissors, ruler,
coloured pencils or felt-
tipped pens, pencil

1 Fold the paper into thirds.

2 Cut the right-hand side of the paper into thirds, evenly spaced apart.

3 Cut the left-hand side of the paper into thirds, using a ruler to make sure the cuts line up with the right-hand side cuts.

4 Draw a figure or animal in the middle uncut part of the paper. Make sure there is a head and neck in the top third, a body in the middle part and legs in the bottom third of the paper. Colour it in.

5 Flip the right-hand middle piece of paper over and draw a new body, lining the body up with the head, adding some interesting clothes. Flip the top right-hand piece of paper over and draw a new head, flip over the bottom piece of paper and draw new legs.

6 Do the same with the left-hand flaps of paper. It's super funny if the new heads, bodies and legs are completely different from your original figure. For instance, you might draw a cat in the middle uncut part of the paper, then for the other leg flaps draw a mermaid tail and snake; for the heads you might draw a teddy bear and a duck, and for the bodies you might draw a tutu and a striped windcheater.

7 Have fun mixing and matching your bodies, heads and legs in different combinations. Cool!
